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Question and hypothesis

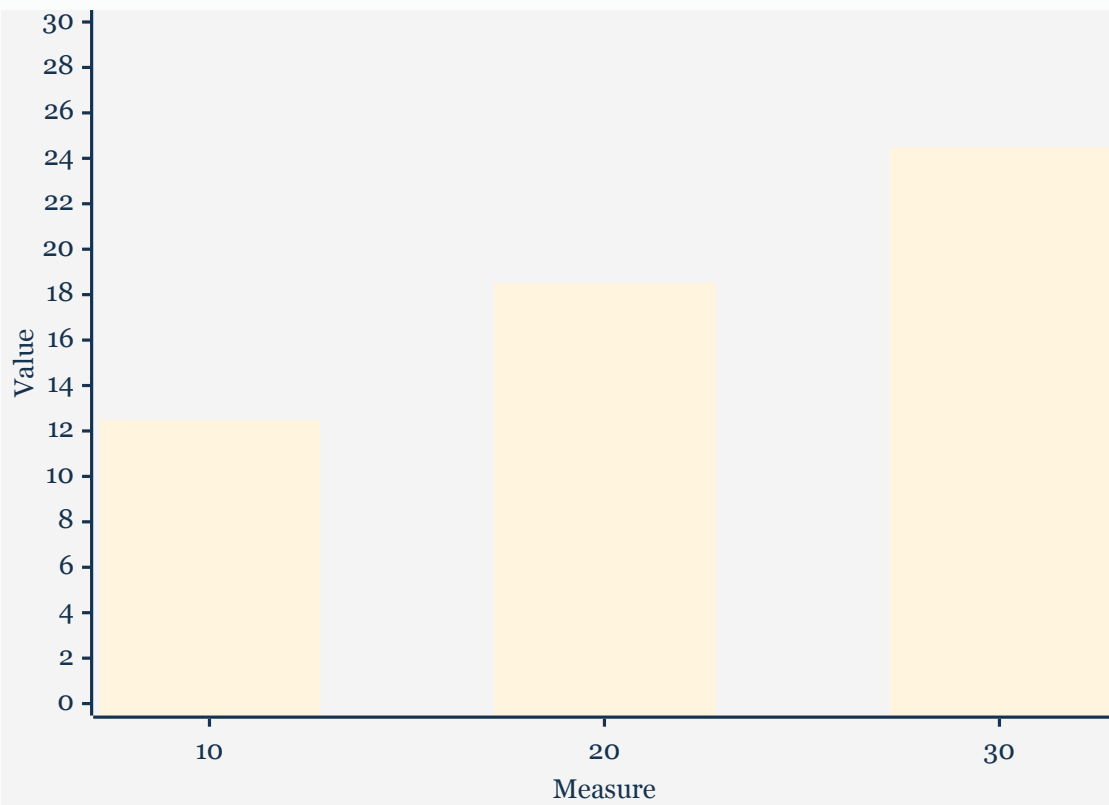
The evidence supports a practical claim about Light Intensity and Seedling Growth, while the strongest limitation is stated rather than hidden.
